

Public Art, Oakland



The Greater Mysteries by Randy Colosky

Chandra Cerrito / Art Advisors was honored to lead one of Oakland's first public art in private development projects for 19H, a new residential building at 19th and Harrison in the city's downtown. *The Greater Mysteries* by local artist Randy Colosky is a 70-foot long mural and 36 suspended stainless steel spheres that together celebrate the creative spirits of the victims of Oakland's tragic Ghost Ship fire on December 2, 2016. The work also recalls the wonder of celestial navigation, and how we are participating in a vast sea of energetic waves, atoms, photons, planets, stars, galaxies and the fabric of spacetime itself. There are 36 star lights in this project to represent each person lost in the fire, and to contemplate that ultimately, we are all stardust.

## **Public Art, Sunnyvale**

CC/AA facilitated the conceptual design and city approval process for a monumental public artwork by artist Rob Ley, which was proposed to fulfill the City's public art in private development requirement. After close collaboration among the artist, developer, design team, building contractor, and City staff, Ley developed a design for a stunning sculptural facade that wraps three sides of a parking garage at the center of Catalyst, a new corporate campus with three office buildings.

This dynamic artwork will offer varied perceptual experiences, depending on one's viewing angle. The piece is composed of thousands of folded and painted aluminum elements, and when viewed directly, exhibits leaf-like light and dark green colors. As the viewer moves and views the artwork from the side, the folded forms of the individual elements reveal a vivid hue of blue, reflective of the sky above.

Folded Forest will be an iconic feature that will not only greatly enhance the project site, but will also provide a noteworthy addition to the City's substantial public art collection. It received unanimous approval from the Sunnyvale Arts Commission.
