Public Art Walnut Creek

Spiraling and Radiating Light by Dan Corson

Acclaimed artist Dan Corson created two wall-mounted sculptures for a new parking garage at the Walnut Creek BART station. Utilizing reclaimed street light fixtures, the sculptures illuminate with various sequences of colored light, including patterns that are triggered by the timing of train arrivals and departures. Visible from both the ground and elevated train tracks, these dynamic artworks create an especially engaging and memorable experience for BART riders.




## Public Art Oakland
